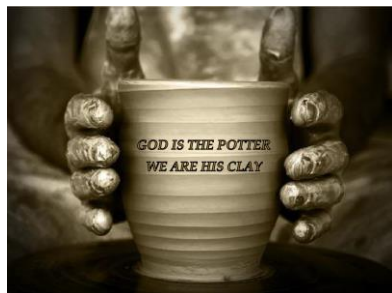

Community Project - A Rain Garden near St Anthony's

For the information of the community, yesterday I met with managers from the 'Rain Garden' project, which is being built adjacent to St Anthony's on the Athllon Drive side of the school property. It is essentially a water quality project. The Rain Garden will consist of various tiers of plants, landscaping and catchment ponds designed to filter out certain undesirable chemicals from the rain water that makes its way into the main catchment of Lake Tuggeranong. It appears the Rain Garden covers an area of about approximately 400m by about 60m. The rain garden will include 3 shallow filtration ponds which will have a depth of about 300 mm. The rain garden project will take about 6 months to complete. The bike path is closed during the project but will re-open at the end.

Semester 1 Reports Home this Friday

Semester 1 Student Reports will come home with students this Friday, the end of Week 9. Kindergarten students receive a special report designed for their level of learning, but students in Years 1 to 6 will receive a report with A-E grading. All reports have a general comment from your child's class teacher.
