VACATION CARE HAPPENINGS

The curriculum has been designed to be flexible and child centered, giving the children an opportunity to make decisions and take control of their day. Allowing the staff and children to evaluate the activities daily ensures that the program provided reflects on the children's interests and allows for an extension on the previous day's learning.

WEEK 1:

Tuesday 26th of September – Incursion – Kiddie Kart

Kiddie Karts are coming to OOSCA for the morning. Each child will have the opportunity to drive in a Kart around an inflatable track.

Wednesday 27th of September – Incursion – Disco

Complete Entertainment are coming to host an 80's OOSCA disco. Children are encouraged to come dressed in 80's clothes to enjoy a morning of dancing, fun and games.

Thursday 28th of September – Excursion – Hoyts Woden – Movie TBA

The children will watch a movie in a private theatre. A small popcorn and water will be provided, but please pack extra morning tea/snacks if your child would like something extra during the movie. **No spending money for the movies please.**

Friday 29th of September – Excursion – Floriade

We will be walking amongst the flowers.

Spending money is allowed for the rides only, we will not be going on the Ferris wheel.

WEEK 2:

Tuesday 3rd of October – Excursion – Yarralumla Play Station

We will be playing 18 holes of putt putt, catching a train to the animals at the petting farm and enjoying lunch at the park.

Wednesday 4th of October – Excursion – Kambah Adventure Park

Today we will enjoy a Sausage sizzle provided by OOSCA and a play at the park.

Thursday 5th of October – Incursion – The Jollybops Science Show

We look at the scientific principles behind some of the great inventions and environmental understandings of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander People. In this fun, musical and interactive show children will learn about the science of the Boomerang, Didgeridoo and lots more!

Friday 6th of October – At OOSCA – OOSCA Master Chef

Today the children will become chefs. All meals will be provided for as the children will cook and prepare a range of bite sized food for us all to enjoy.
